MYTH

In order to receive help from Child Care Assistance (CCA), I must apply for child support.

TRUTH

CCA **DOES NOT** require you to apply for child support to receive services. Additionally, we **DO NOT** count any income you receive from child support.



MYTH

I make too much money to qualify for Child Care Assistance.

TRUTH

CCA income limits are much higher than other social services programs. A family of 4 can make up to \$5,814 a month, and still qualify for assistance.



MYTH

In order to receive Child Care Assistance, parent(s) must be US Citizen(s).

TRUTH

Parent(s) are not required to be Citizens of the United States. Only the child(ren) must be US Citizen(s).



MYTH

In order to receive assistance from CCA, I must work a full-time job.

TRUTH

CCA provides assistance to teen parents, part-time employees, active deployed military, and college students.



MYTH

In order to receive assistance from CCA, I have to be a single parent.

TRUTH

CCA provides assistance to single-parents, two-parent families, grandparents, and legal guardians.
